## Welcome to CHIE

The Hampshire Health Record has changed its name to:



This name change highlights the fact that **CHIE** is much more than a data repository or static record. In addition, the imminent inclusion of the Isle of Wight means that the old name no longer accurately describes the area it covers.

The new name better describes the type of system that we run and our ambitions to do more in the future.

Over the next few weeks all patient and staff facing literature (e.g. Fair Processing Notices, User Guides) will be updated to reflect the change in name.

The web addresses (for both our public and staff websites) and main help desk email address will be changing to include the CHIE name and our websites will be updated to include the new branding.

All stakeholder organisations will be provided with logos to use within their own guides, on their intranets and as desktop and Single Sign On web icons/buttons.
